



# Piro Piro Piccolo

Piro Piro Piccolo (sandpiper in Italian) is a small bird commonly found on the beaches around Santa Barbara. Piro Piro Piccolo is a collaborative project between Martellotto Wines and Demetria Estate. We wanted to make a second label to expand our line of wines and offer elegant wine in an informal package.

	
<p><b>2006 Piro Piro Piccolo Chardonnay Sta. Rita Hills</b></p> <p><b>Vineyard Notes:</b> This sandy loam vineyard is in the far west part of the appellation.</p> <p><b>Winemaking Notes:</b> The wine was tank fermented and barreled for ten months in used French oak. 100% ML</p> <p><b>Tasting Notes:</b> Tropical notes of pineapple and pear with lemon and a cinnamon spice combine with a surprisingly food-friendly acidity. Full ML, a mellow oak profile, and balanced alcohol yield a medium bodied wine that's easy to quaff.</p> <p><b>Cases Produced:</b> 435</p>	<p><b>2006 Piro Piro Piccolo Pinot Grigio Sta. Rita Hills</b></p> <p><b>Vineyard Notes:</b> This sandy loam vineyard is in the far west part of the appellation.</p> <p><b>Winemaking Notes:</b> The wine was tank fermented and barreled for ten months in used French oak. 100% ML</p> <p><b>Tasting Notes:</b> This is not a garden-variety PG. It's golden, rich, and has a buttery mouthfeel. Green apples and lemon fruits create a lip-smacking quality. The weight of this wine and touch of vanilla oak persist on the palate.</p> <p><b>Cases Produced:</b> 392</p>
